## A Note From the Executive Director

It has truly been an honor to serve Guiding Star Siouxland since its founding in 2016 - starting as a volunteer, then board member, then Client Service Coordinator, and today as Executive Director. Abby bravely came forward and shared a small part of her journey to choosing life against all odds at the age of 17. My expectations were far exceeded when our first in-person Gala since 2019 met AND surpassed it's fundraising goal!

**Our final EOS strategy meeting was held in May, followed by our Board of Director's annual retreat,** where we further solidified the one, five, and ten year vision for Guiding Star Siouxland. Some of our staff and board had the honor and pleasure of attending the Guiding Star Project's Gala in June, where footage from Abby's story was shared again as the Project detailed their vision to provide a Guiding Star Center in every state. 


